

RE

In RE, we will look at sacred places and discussing 'If God is everywhere, why go to a place of worship?'. Pupils will make connections between how believers feel about places of worship in different traditions and describe the most important functions of a place of worship.

Computing

This half term, pupils will create their very own web page and preview it as it will appear on different devices. They will then suggest or make edits to improve the user experience on each device.

DT/Art and Design

In Art, pupils will create artwork based on and inspired by landscapes. They will experiment with various watercolour techniques and understand atmospheric perspective and use it in a piece of art.

PE

In PE, pupils will be taught 'Teaching movement for understanding' where they will look at creating sequences through gymnastics. Pupils will be attending the local swimming pool and participating in a 12 week block of swimming lessons.

Geography

This half term, pupils will develop a knowledge of the continents of the world. They will be learning about the differences between a country and a continent. Pupils will learn how these continents are the same and different from each other through their location in relation to the equator, northern hemisphere, southern hemisphere, arctic and Antarctic circles.

Maths

In Maths, we will be securing and embedding our knowledge and understanding of addition and subtraction. Pupils will be exposed to fluency, reasoning and problem-solving questions to ensure that they have an in depth understanding of number.

English

In English, we will be reading the novel 'Room 13', where pupils will be looking at the effect that vocabulary has on the reader. Pupils will be taught '*Point, Evidence, Explain*' in order to answer questions in greater depth. Pupils will be writing their own mystery story where they will include many of the Key Stage 2 writing skills.

PSCHE

In PSCHE, pupils will be focussing on wellbeing, this will be specifically mental health and the importance of this. We will be looking at case studies, videos and holding whole class debates to fully understand what is meant by our mental health and what we need to do to have positive mental health.

Science

In science, pupils will be focusing on physics where they will be looking at light; reflection, refracting light and how we see colours. Pupils will continue to develop their scientific skills in preparation for Year 7

Languages

Pupils will continue their learning of the Spanish language. We will be specifically looking at colours, days of the week and months of the year.
